- 1. Because this report is read by a machine, please take caution not to damage it by folding or tearing the document etc.
- 2. Because incorrect information in this registration can lead to complications for the applicant (Non-registration as overseas absentee, inability to receive election information, etc.), please fill in all information legibly and accurately.
- 3. Those who have falsely registered or those who have not been deemed to have registered on one's own intention cannot participate in voting and may be punished (up to 3 years of imprisonment or a fine of up to 5 million Korean Won) in accordance with Article 247 of the 'Public Official Election Act.'

***** Tips

- 1. For the "Name" field, you must write your name as shown in your passport (including English).
 - However, if your name is different on your passport and family relation register (family register), you must write your name on your family relation register (family register).
- 2. In the "Overseas Voter Category" field, the "Canceled Korean Resident Registration Number" must be entered after marking the \square in the corresponding field for people who had a resident registration number in Korea. For persons who never had a resident registration number in Korea, your "Date of Birth" must be written after marking the \square in the corresponding field and the \square must be checked in the corresponding field of "Gender."
- 3. In the "Names of Parents" field, those who never had resident registration number in Korea must enter the "Father's Name or Mother's Name" shown in the family relation register (family register) for the accurate confirmation of citizenship/identification and place of registration (address of the original domicile).
- 4. In the "Family Relation Registration Information" field, the "Final Address in Republic of Korea" must be entered after marking the ☑ in the corresponding field for people who had a Korean resident registration number (canceled resident registration). For persons who never had a resident registration number in Korea, the "Place of Family Registration (Address of Original Domicile)" shown on the family relation register (family register) must be written after marking ☑ in the corresponding field.
- 5. In the "Phone Number" and "Cell Phone Number" fields, phone numbers (country code area code phone number) such as home, office or cell phone number must be written to enable contact from the residing country.
 - Because the phone number and cell phone number are used for instructions such as confirmation of overseas voter criteria, voting time/location, and for providing other various election information, you can write down a phone number in Korea that can be contacted if you do not have a foreign number.
- 6. You must fill in the "E-mail" field because it is used to provide various election-related information/materials such as political party/candidate information prepared and sent by the National Election Commission, notification of voter list registration, guide to appeal application, and voting time/location/requirements
- 7. In the "Overseas Address" field, the location where you can receive mail from the residing country must be accurately written inside the dotted line using the Roman alphabet or block capital letters (local language can be additionally used).
 - However, a **diplomatic mission can be reported as an overseas address to receive mail** for reasons such as work/profession/relocation/unclear address/poor mailing system of the residing country. In this case, after marking the \square , enter the name of the diplomatic mission in the "Address" field.
- 8. In the "diplomatic mission to be used for voting" field, write the name of the diplomatic mission where you will be actually voting during the overseas voting period.
- 9. In the "Applicant" field at the end, you must write your name and sign or seal.
